Search strategy tips

1. Think synonyms - Example: perpetrator OR offender
2. Truncation- Add* after root word to search all forms –Example: interview*
3. Use “ ” for phrases- Example: “child sexual abuse”
4. Narrow searches by dates, publication types, or authors
5. Ask a librarian
